##### *Key responsibilities*

- ◆ Manage and supervise intensive persons in recovery (PIR) cases for the “Pilot Project on Transitional Support Service for Persons in Mental Recovery (Kowloon Central, Kwai Chung, Tsuen Wan)”;
- ◆ Supervise a clustered-based multi-disciplinary outreaching service team with medical-social collaboration so as to provide a stop-gap, timely and enhanced transitional support for PIRs;
- ◆ Assist in development of a sustainable service model to ensure effective service delivery and good social impact;
- ◆ Engage effective stakeholder partnership and networking, as well as mobilising available resources for the service advancement and development to ensure smooth user journey of the PIRs along their recovery pathway; and
- ◆ Prepare timely, accurate and informative reports and related documentation of the Project.
