## Assistant Project Manager (Building Services) (Wan Chai)

This is a fixed-term full-time contract position of 18 months.

## Key responsibilities:

- Support the team in various building services, extra low voltage (ELV) system, energy management and smart system issues from inception to completion and monitor the design, planning and construction of the redevelopment of Shau Kei Wan House (SKWH), the Jockey Club "Craft Your Life Together" Co-living Community Project (JCCCP);
- Supervise and inspect the installation of building services including work progress, quality control and testing & commissioning;
- Manage the construction project including review of consultants' and contractors' submission to ensure all works are up to required standards, within budget and on schedule;
- Report to Building Project Manager, liaise and coordinate with internal & external stakeholders including funder, governing committee, consultants, contractors and supervisor to ensure smooth implementation of the project;
- Handle contract administration work, prepare progress reports, meeting papers and other related documents; and
- Perform any other necessary duties as assigned by Supervisor.

## Requirements

- Post-secondary education in Building Services, Electrical & Mechanical Engineering or related disciplines, possession of relevant professional membership is an advantage;
- Minimum 5 years' relevant project management experience preferably gained in properties & facilities management or consultant companies;
- Knowledge in building services installation, ELV and smart system for composite building
- A good team player with strong leadership, problem solving, communication and organizational skills;
- Self-motivated, high integrity, innovative and able to perform multi-tasks within tight deadline;
- Proficient in Microsoft Office and work-related software applications;
- Good command of spoken and written English and Chinese; and
