

Blue Bus Jockey Club Phase Two project: Holistic Service Supporting Children and youth with Incarcerated Parents ("BBJC")

BBJC is a 3-year project aims to acknowledge and incorporate children's rights, voice and children's perspective by strategic engagement with policy makers, key stakeholders unfolding along the judicial system in which children's parents are involved. The project will rigorously review the pain points and loopholes in the service gaps among concerned government departments and service operators with emphasis on the service needs of children and youth with incarcerated parents so as to shoot the problems by driving system change.

Key Responsibilities

- Supervise the pool of Family Aid Supporters/ Peer Supporters to provide guidance to exoffenders' parents, caregivers or children to develop household management and self-care skills;
- Organise and implement various activities of the project, and provide assistance and training to parents, caregivers to acquire the child care skills and knowledge;
- Assist in implementing mentoring programmes and prison escort services;
- Handle members' application for project activities;
- Operate resource lending system, such as toys, books, and video tapes; and
- Photo-shooting and video production for the Project.
